What have we done so far?



In the past few months, we have been working on the development of the first activities of the Project Result 1: Educational Programme in AI Literacy. Each partner has conducted interviews with AI specialists and adult trainers in the field of ICTs, which allowed us to receive up-to-date information on the developments of AI and technology and on the challenges of the sector.

Using the conclusions of the interviews as a departing point, we have started developing an adequate methodology and structuring the contents of the educational programme. All together, partners have already decided which topics will be approached, and will soon be starting to work on them.

How will the Educational Programme be structured?

The Training Itinerary has been prepared to target the needs of different adults, and allow them a true progression in their knowledge. In that sense, the Educational Programme will have three levels: Basic, Intermediate and Advanced. In each one of these levels, the same broad topics will be addressed, even if in different degrees of difficulty and complexity.

The contents will fall into the following modules:

- Introduction to AI
- Key Concepts (process)
- AI-Human Interaction
- Advantages/scenarios/ applications
- Risk & Threats (including ethical issues)

The subtopics to be included into each one of these matters will be different, appropriate to each level. Moreover, the Educational Programme will have a transversal Glossary and a Digital Competences Framework (DIGCOMP) which will support the learning process.



What are the next steps?

Very soon, the partners will meet for their second Transnational Meeting in Porto, Portugal. This occasion will allow them to discuss about the template for the creation of the modules and promptly start working in their development. They will also start debating about the creation of the digital platform to support the presentation of the contents.
