



## Welcome to the fourth and last newsletter of the ArIN project!

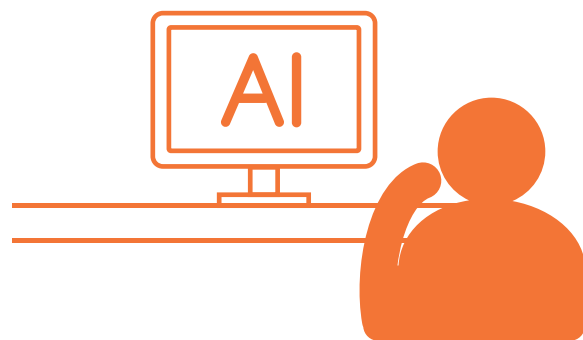
### What have we done so far?



The time for reflection has arrived! ArIN project is coming to an end, and that means that we need to look back to see what we achieved in the last 24 months. After hard work, a lot of meetings, strong cooperation and precious knowledge exchanges with AI experts and educators, we have been able to deliver our main result: the Educational Programme in AI Literacy, which consists mainly of educational modules structured into three levels of difficulty - Basic, Intermediate and Advanced - but counts with many other things.
